COLLEGE AND CAREER EXPO OFFERS MORE THAN \$750,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS AT KENTUCKY EXPOSITION CENTER

LOUISVILLE, KY (September 15, 2015) – The College and Career Expo returns to the Kentucky Exposition Center on Sunday, September 20 for its 24th year of providing education and career opportunities. Attracting more than 12,000 attendees, this event is one of the largest college and career expos in the country.

Prospective students and job seekers can meet with more than 250 exhibitors from across the country including colleges, universities, vocational schools and employers. College recruiters, career counselors and admission representatives can meet individually with prospective students in one convenient location. Attendees could receive a portion of the \$750,000 in scholarships that will be available at this event.

One of the top 10 largest public facilities of its kind in the United States, the Kentucky Exposition Center features 1.2 million square feet of contiguous exhibit space including Freedom Hall, an indoor arena which seats over 19,000 people. ABOUT PARKING

Conveniently located adjacent to the Louisville International Airport and near the junction of three major interstates, the Kentucky Exposition Center is easily accessible and just five minutes south of downtown Louisville. The spacious grounds have 19,000 parking spaces and is accessible from six gates surrounding the facility. Gates are located off of Phillips Lane, Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle and \$20 per bus.
